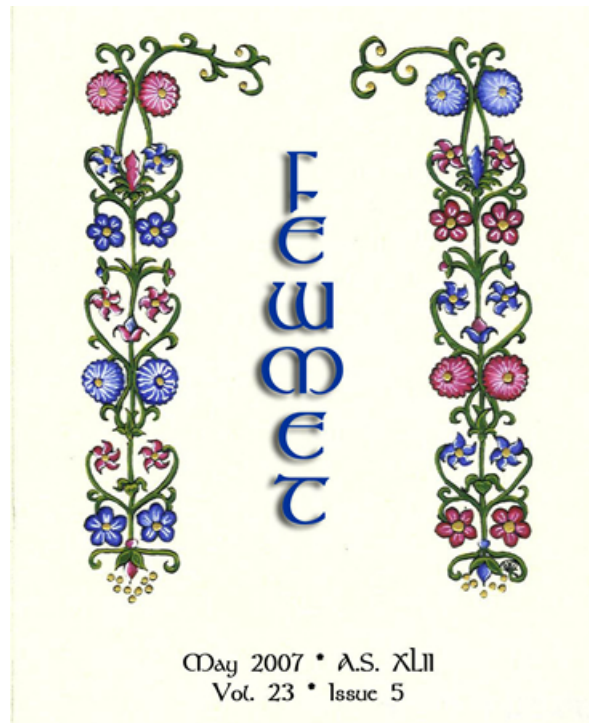
From the Baron and Baroness

1. Officers Reports

Knight Marshal: Vettius announced that official fight practice will be moving to Sunday afternoons from 11:30 to 1:30; there is no official fight practice right now. We have one new authorized fighter. We will be participating in the annual Adams Street martial arts demo tomorrow, so all fighters and other folks are invited to join us. **Chatelaine:** Nothing is going on right now, Dubheasa said. I'm waiting for confirmation on a couple of demos. **Webministers:** Sorcha reminded everyone that there will be an electronic reminder to submit items to the Fewmet by the 7th of each month.

Archery: Practice is cancelled this Sunday, but will continue next week at the Creekwood range, Cedric reported. Practice will move outdoors to RIT next month as soon as the weather gets warmer.

Herald: Matilda announced that the next heraldic consult meeting will be on the second Tuesday in April at her house. Bryn asked if future meetings could be scheduled at a time other than the same night as Cooks Guild, so that she and cooks can attend it.

Rapier: We have four fencers showing up regularly, Yasmina said. I've started planning for the Rapier Academy event, and am creating a website in preparation for the announcement.

Exchequer: We have \$2,626.35 in checking and \$3,113.33 in saving, Alina reported. She's finished the College of Three Ravens report.

Thrown Weapons: "We have no practice yet, we can't see the butts in the yard!" said Alison, speaking for Timothy.

Arts & Sciences: Vivat to Her Ladyship Bryn on receiving her Fleur, Kadlin announced. She congratulated everyone who entered (Collette, Fridrikr, and Una) or judged the Pent at Ice Dragon, and thanked those who painted 12 Black Talon and eight Broche medallions. [Note from Katja & Eric: THANK YOU!!] Upcoming social meetings may include basic beginner garb, scroll cases, and leather award medallions for the kingdom.

Chronicler: Mairghread repeated Sorcha's announcement that she'll be sending out electronic reminders each month for the Fewmet's deadline. She thanked Eldjarn and his staff for the newest edition of the Thescorre Domesday.

Chirurgion: Ice Dragon was uneventful, Phillipe reported.

Historian: I'm always looking for new material, he added.

Baron & Baroness: Thanks for the baronial award medallions! Katja said. Thanks also to all the wonderfully industrious gentles who volunteered at Ice Dragon as marshals, tollners, kitchen help and, of course, Pent judges and staff.

Cauldron Bleu: It seemed like folks really enjoyed the recent shortbread class, Bryn said, so we'll be doing that again at an upcoming meeting. We'll also be baking bread and doing vigil cookies. Come cook with us!

Dance: Middle Eastern dance & drum practice is at Eldjarn's tomorrow night, Dehka announced. "My shimmy is temporarily out of order, but please come to drum and learn how to dance. I would love, love, love to choreograph a dance to the drum song that Carlo has written. It will be fun!" As for Western, Peregrine reported, I have the list of the dances planned for the grand ball at Pennsic, and we will be working on those over the next couple of months.

MOL: Nothing to report at this time, Bronwyn said.

Threadworkers: We're meeting this Sunday at Carlo & Juliana's to work on patterns for constructing garments,

Matilda said.

2. Ice Dragon

Fridrikr thanked everyone who worked at the Pent. We had fewer people, due to the storm, but the quality of the entries was really very high. We went from six to 11 rubrics this year, he added, and I hope to double that number next year. He encouraged everyone to consider entering the competition next year. (He entered for the first time in many years this time.)

3. College of Three Ravens

The event was highly successful, Fridrikr announced. We had a lot of great teachers, a great meal, and the best bardic I've seen in a long, long time at feast! The church was extremely impressed with us, with how well we left the property and how hard we worked. There were 225 in attendance and 112 at feast, which was more than we planned. Our profit is \$745.97, which is double what we anticipated. Our cooks worked very hard to be under budget, he explained, plus we had a lot more attendants than we expected. Their Majesties were very impressed with the barony and the event, he added. He thanked the staff, the cooks, the autocrat, and the drummers. Finally, the church gave us a LOT of very nice photos of the event, which will be going up on the barony website.

4. Rapier Academy

"It's going to happen. Yay!" Yasmina commented. In answer to a question at last month's meeting, the deposit is refundable in full if requested 30 days before the event. The owner is willing to bend over backwards to accommodate us on rooms and tables, she added, although he said that if we need more than 500 tables, he'll have to order out...! Also, he will work out some sort of discount restaurant voucher for us. There are two concession stands in the arena, so to call it a "wet site" is an understatement. ("Drenched?" someone quipped.) The "green room" below the arena can be reserved for royalty. This will not be an Æthelmearc Academy, just a rapier academy; however, we can have arts tracks with a rapier arts orientation (such as making rapier armor).

5. Pax

Katrina offered a bid at the same site as last year, Genesee Country Campground in Caledonia. Dubheasa will be head cook, and Nikolai has offered to cook a whole roast pig as one of the courses. We can camp this year in the camping area, not all on the field. The feast will be raised \$1 to cover the cost of the pig, so it will be \$6 for feast and \$5 for site fee. Alison noted that last year the owners wanted us to camp primarily on the field, but since they don't get that many other campers they're fine with us using the rest of the campground. We can even use the golf course for martial activities. We had 108 attending the event last year, with 50 camping. There are six cabins that are available for renting, although they are really small. If someone wants to reserve a cabin, please contact the site directly and you can get a discount. Katrina said she will find out if there will be another pancake breakfast on Sunday morning.

There was some debate as to whether the planned date in July would conflict with St. Swithin's Bog Three-Day event, which Katja and Eric plan to attend in support of the barony rapier champion, Yasmina. After a phone call to the site, Katrina offered to change the date to June 29 through July 1 so as not to conflict with either the other event or the national Independence Day holiday. Those present voted 23-0-1 to approve the event.

6. Champs

Eric and Katja announced that they are seeking bids for their next champions tourney.

7. Recruitment

Peregrine announced two teams of Thescorreans to pursue recruitment at the University of Rochester and the Rochester Institute of Technology: Kadlin, Sigvaldi, Bryn, Yasmina, Pleasance, Mairghread, and Orianna for RIT;

Dubheasa, Cedric, Karen, Vettius, Eldjarn, Bryn, Kadlin, and Sigvaldi for UR. If anyone wants to help out, please contact them.

1. Officers Reports

MOL: Nothing to report, Bronwyn said.

Exchequer: We have \$2,442.35 in checking and \$3,113.99 in savings, Alina reported. She reapplied for her warrant from the kingdom. Her term is up in July, but she is willing to reapply for another term if no one else is interested in the office. Peregrine will accept any officer bids.

Knight Marshal: Vettius noted that the fighters are waiting for the weather to improve so that they can start holding heavy fighting practice outside. Currently, the plan is to switch the practice to Sundays from 11:30 to 1:30 at Genesee Valley Park (so that gentles can have a half an hour to go to archery practice).

Herald: I've dropped dead! Matilda exulted, adding that as of Crown Tourney she will become Silver Buccle Herald. Pleasance, who was Matilda's drop dead deputy, is now Raven's Tongue Pursuivant for Thescorre.

In other heraldic news, heraldic meetings will continue at Matilda's home on the second Tuesday of each month. In addition, the scribal meetings at Pleasance and Matteo's home on alternate months will be a combined scribal/ heraldic meeting.

Further, Dame Margaret Makafee has offered to hold an all-day Laurel Road Show in Thescorre, so if anyone is interested in learning how the Laurel College of Arms makes decisions on passing names and devices.

Arts & Sciences: Kadlin reported that all guilds are having regular meetings. Last month, her friend Nick gave a recorder demo. Since she has "half a cow" of leather, she'd like to have people create kingdom award medallions at an upcoming social meeting; scroll cases is another possible project. Since there have been a number of newcomers lately, she and Sigvaldi are considering holding a newcomers night at their home to demonstrate such things as basic garb.

Chirurgion: Gordon is our newest apprentice chirurgion, Phillipe reported. His term of office is up in July, and he will reapply if no one else is interested.

Historian: Still accepting materials, Phillipe added. He asked if his office had a term limit, which it does not.

Seneschale: Peregrine noted that several officers' terms are up in July, as heard in earlier reports. Terms beginning in July will run through 2009. The next baronial Curia is July 17; if anyone wants to propose any changes to Thescorre's laws and rules, please give a draft to Peregrine by the May business meeting. Several officers were unable to attend tonight's meeting and emailed her their reports.

Chatelaine: Speaking for Dubheasa, Peregrine read that the gold key collection is in Dubheasa's attic and she's expecting several demos soon.

Rapier: Reading Yasmina's report, Peregrine said that there is one new fencer at practice and Yasmina is working on the announcement for Rapier Academy. Responding to His Excellency Eric's request, Yasmina will ask the Armory owner if we can do equestrian at the Academy event. (The site had stalls for horses at the beginning of last century.)

Chronicler: Speaking for Mairghread, Peregrine said that the Fewmet is online and thanks for the article submissions.

Webminister: Speaking for Donal & Sorcha, Peregrine read that the April Fewmet is online and there is nothing major to report.

Archery: Finally, speaking for Cedric, Peregrine said there was nothing to report.

Baron & Baroness: We attended Coronation and swore fealty to Their Majesties Rurik & Angelik, Katja reported, and we very much thank Baroness Una for heralding us into Court while Her Ladyship Matilda was helping to herald the Court. For those of you who didn't know, in addition to new royalty we have a new kingdom seneschale (Her Excellency Caryl), a new exchequer (Mistress Cynthia), and a new media representative (Lord John). We

expect to attend Crown next month, and hope to attend Æthelmearc War Practice and/or Æthelmearc 10 Year Celebration. We are seeking bids to autocrat our annual baronial champs event. Finally, we learned this past weekend that equestrian is fun! (We met Master Alexander and Mistress Rannveigr's gorgeous, ginormous Frisians.)

Middle Eastern Dance & Drum: We're meeting tomorrow night at Eldjarn's, Carlo said. (Tonight's coffee is Vermont Maple Nut Crunch!)

Scriptorium: We're going to start alternating our monthly meetings between scribes only and scribes & heralds, Collette announced. For example, the May meeting will be heralds and scribes, while the June one will be just scribes. All meetings are at Pleasance & Matteo's home.

Crown Tourney bid

Orianna presented the bid she had emailed earlier in the day to Caryl, the kingdom seneschale, for consideration tonight. The site is the Genesee Country Campground, Caledonia (same site as last Pax and Champs). Proposed date is October 6, 2007, and the date is already penciled in on the camp's calendar.

Cost for renting the site for the day is \$700, so Orianna proposed a \$6 site fee (\$5 for site fee, \$1 for kingdom profit) and \$4 lunch fee. Since it would be October, no camping is expected or planned.

As per recent discussions on the Thescore Yahoo list, the lunch would be an all-day sideboard with several courses spread through the afternoon until Court. There is no dinner planned, since Crown Tournes over the last several years have generally had low attendance.

Olivia has agreed to be head cook, to coordinate various people preparing a dish or two each; Orianna hopes the Cauldron Bleu Cooks Guild will help. Staffing needs are a tollner (Fridrikr will be organizing the heralds in the tourney list), as well as royalty liaison and setup/cleanup crew.

Those present approved the bid 14-0-2.

Increased Media Attention and Guidelines

In the past few years, the Society has been garnering increased media attention, some due to the efforts of the Society and Kingdom Press Officers, some through situations beyond our control. While that can be a positive thing, raising awareness of the Society's activities in the outside world, expanding our potential for educational outreach and enhancing the image of the Society as a whole, there is also a downside which will require extra vigilance from local groups. There are media sources which are more interested in sensationalist coverage than in portraying the organization in an accurate manner.

First, a caution to parents: there have been incidents where an individual has approached minors claiming to be a reporter wanting information on the organization, but refusing to speak with parents. When we contacted the media outlet whom the individual claimed to be representing, the media outlet had no reporters who had contacted us. They also assured us that they would not have approached minors without first talking to, and obtaining permission from, the parents. Please be on your guard for this ruse, especially in public settings.

Next, there has been an increased amount of attention from national/highend media, including magazines, professional and student filmmakers & documentarians, and reality TV shows. If any of these media outlet contact you, the contact should never be handled at the local level. Refer the contact immediately to your Kingdom Media Rep; it will most likely be handled at a Society level. Permission to film at any SCA function for anything other than personal viewing can only be obtained from the Corporate level. Permission requests go to the Society Seneschal, via the Society Press Office.

Additionally, permission to use the names, logos and insignia of the Society for Creative Anachronism, Inc. for any media venture must be obtained through the President of the SCA, via the Society Seneschal/Society Press Office. This includes the names and heraldry of Kingdoms, Baronies and local branches, as well as the Society as a whole.

Finally, a note about Internet video. Please let common sense prevail. Do not post any copyrighted material (video or audio) for which you do not hold the copyright without obtaining written permission from the copyright holder.

Begin your day by watching the hounds of Aethelmearc run their courses! Then move on to martial arts. Or, take in a class or two.

Martial Arts - with reward to the winners!

Heavy Fighting - a double elimination tourney. The winner will receive a commerative wooden broad sword (not suitable for combat), a stained glass treasure fashioned by Lady Sueva the Short, and a \$10.00 gift card from Sheetz (good for gas, food, or other necessities). After the tourney, melees will be organized, complete with combat archery.

Come get in one last practice for the Great Pennsic War.

Rapier - The form of the tourney will depend on the number of participants. The winner will receive a commerative wooden broad sword (not suitable for combat), a stained glass treasure by Lady Sueva the Short, and a \$10.00 gift certificate from Sheetz.

Archery - The form of the tourney will depend on the number of participants. Royal Rounds and a fun shoot are planned. The winner will receive a \$10.00 gift certificate from Three Rivers Archery, a stained glass treasure fashioned by Lady Sueva the Short, and a \$10.00 gift certificate from Sheetz.

Thrown Weapons - The form of the tourney will depend of the number of the participants. Royal Rounds and a fun throw are planned. The winner will receive a commerative throwing knife, a stained glass treasure fashioned by Lady Sueva the Short, and a \$10.00 gift certificate.

Heavy Youth Combat - We will have heavy youth combat tourneys for Division I, II, and III. The winner of each division will receive a commerative wooden sword, and a \$10.00 gift certificate for Wal - Mart.

Arts and Sciences - with rewards to the winners

To remind our citizens of last year's plague, we ask that artists of all stripes make monsters, beasts, and demons in any media. Items will be judged by a panel of A&S experts. Judging will be on appearance, periodness, and documentation. The winner will receive a \$35.00 Gift Certificate from the SCA Store - may be used to purchase a membership. Youth participants in the A&S competition will receive a special participation award.

NEW, NEW, NEW - a Fishing Derby - The site has a lovely small pond. A good and kind gentle from Atlantia has stepped forward, and offered to Judge a Fishing derby. Prizes will be given for the Largest Sunfish, and the Largest Not-A-Sunfish. This is a catch and release derby (fish must be alive and swim away to count). The competition is open to all, any age, any level of expertise. All participants must use fishing gear that is "periodish" (wooden sticks, any kind of fishing line (including monofiliment), natural material bobbers (cork, wood, etc.) and real worms, bread, cheese, baits are fine; (crank reels ,telescoping rods, plastic bobbers rubber worms, plastic minnows or commercial baits are not) Note - Do not use live minnows. Fishing kits will be available at troll for anyone under 15 years old, who brings a parent to the event (Parents are solely responsible for the supervision of their child or children. Neither the fishing marshall, nor the autocrat accept any responsibility for children at this event. A parent or designated gardian must be with a child at all times). **IMPORTANT - ANY-ONE OVER 15 YEARS OLD NEEDS A VALID WV FISHING LICENSE!** These are available on line from the West Virginia Dept. of Natural Resources . They are also available from any WV Wal - Mart, or WV Sporting, Hunting, Fishing Store. There is a one day license available to anyone (out - of - state) for \$15.00. The Fish and Game warden has promised to visit during the day, so be prepared - keep your license on your person while you

are fishing (it MUST be on your person, not in your tent, or car!).

Classes - We are offering a basketry class (10:00 am and 2:00 pm), and other classes (perhaps a combat archery class ??) as instructors come forward.

An entertainment competition - After Feast anyone may try their luck at entertaining the masses. Winner will be by popular vote. Gift certificates will go to the winner - a \$10.00 gift certificate from the SCA and a \$10.00 Sheetz gift card.

A fine feast will be had by those lucky enough to reserve a seat. Dishes will include a roasted chicken, a baked trout, and braised pork, each with accompanying sides (Please see our website for ingredients and details). If a member of your party needs Off Board Seating, please make arrangements with our reservationist., Lady Marija Kotok.

Details, Details, Details - The site opens at 6:00 pm on Friday, and closes at 6:00 pm on Sunday. The site is DRY. No ground camp fires (camp stoves, grills and small, above ground, container fires are acceptable). Also, the site is a public park, so there will be non-scadians in attendance. Be prepared to answer questions.

Costs/Fees/Prices
