Baroness Una de Saint Luc was called forward and sent to sit vigil for the Order of the Laurel.

Tuesday the 7th, on the field

Lady Alessandra Bentivegna da Faenza was called before Their Majesties and created a member of the Order of the White Scarf for her intimidating skill in the art of Fence.

Evening Court, in the Barn

THL Robert Marston, Aethelmearc's Kingdom Chirurgeon, came before the court to recognize the accomplishments of Lord Liam Mac an Tsaoir and Lord Philipe the Shamed, who have each achieved the status of Mentor Chirurgeon.

Baron Leonard the Younger was invited before Their Majesties to answer if he would accept the honor They wished to bestow upon him. Having obtained his agreement, Their Majesties called for those who would speak to his worth. Baron Fridrikr Tomasson av Knusslig Hamn read a praise poem about Baron Leonard, commissioned by Baron Tofi Kerthjalfadsson.

While some sewed list pennants for Crown, others researched names and devices, worked on armor, petted animals, passed the baby, or discussed recruitment handouts.

Recruitment Literature Discussion

Peregrine opened the discussion as gentles shared examples of recruitment handouts from the Hael and other groups. Dehka and others strongly recommended creating a couple of different handouts, rather than just one to cover all situations. "It took me a long time to realize that there were all these other things to do," she noted, since it's not really obvious on the webpage or in casual conversation all the varied things we do. However, she said she felt a long list of activities on a handout tends to be boring and; she recommended specific handouts or jazzy layouts to grab attention and prevent someone from losing interest halfway down while scanning down a long list of activities.

Eldjarn suggested one handout on general information about the SCA and Thescorre, then several ones on specific topics. He strongly recommended creating a large trifold screen – with photos – that we can stand up at demos to show off our various interests.

Vettius recommending focusing on the things we can offer people, like free sword fighting lessons. "College students like free!" Dehka commented.

Katja recommended creating one general handout which we can hand out to community groups when they want a demo – one that explains what we can (and can't) do for them, and a separate pamphlet oriented toward enticing and educating newcomers who want to know what they might be interested in doing with us.

"People have a preconceived notion sometimes about what we do," Dubheasa agreed, saying that as chatelaine she's gotten everything from requests to help with tracing someone's lineage to performing as entertainment.

Richard strongly suggested including a glossary and a FAQ in the brochures, as well as who to contact for more information on various activities, saying that he had difficulty finding those things on the websites. Dubheasa agreed, saying she was confused about a number of common terms and activities until she received the standard SCA glossary sheet with her membership card. Kadlin mentioned that there are already several pieces of good chatelaine material, like glossaries, out there that we can borrow.

After further discussion, those present agreed to creating four handouts:

1. a general one for community groups to explain what we can do and what we DO NOT do
2. an overview for newcomers with a glossary, a brief explanation of all our different activities, a FAQ, and contact information for the different activities
3. one specifically on A&S activities
4. one specifically on all martial activities

Dubheasa recommended asking some fighting and other martial gentles to help with writing the martial one, just as we should ask artisans to help with the A&S one.

Peregrine said she wanted to split up the handouts into individual assignments among different people, so one person didn't have to do them all. There was some discussion about using a consistent layout for all the handouts. Peregrine agreed we should start with one, such as the general handout, then copy and paste sections to the others. Pleasance was asked for her opinion on how to make the handouts eye catching. Dubheasa agreed to work on the glossary, and to ask Kadlin to help with the main body of the general handout.

Dubheasa added that she wanted to buy cardstock to print out more SCA cards; Katja reminded her that Eric had bought blue and white cardstock during the spring specifically for printing more cards for demos (using the card design Sorcha made and uploaded to the barony webpage), and offered to bring her the paper.

Baronial Recruitment Meeting, 8/19/2007

Peregrine, seneschale

15 Thescorreans present, 1 inquisitive child, 1 attention-starved cat

Peregrine opened the meeting by stating the reason for the special meeting: it's hard to have a thorough discussion on recruitment at a normal business meeting, especially with the shortened recreation center hours in the summer. Several people have raised some good ideas for recruitment recently, but she wanted not only to discuss the ideas but to assign specific tasks to gentles by the end of the meeting. Specifically, she wanted people to split up tackling various colleges and their events.

Sigvaldi recommended that the recruitment plan not focus solely on campus recruitment but on boosting recruitment in general. We should be reaching out to the general public, he said, such as festivals like the Park Avenue and Lilac. We've not done the latter for several years,

he said, since it often conflicts with Æ War Practice; however, he noted, not everyone in the Barony goes to any given event, so there's usually someone available to run a table at a local festival on the same day as an SCA event.

The biggest issue, Sigvaldi continued, "is that the general public is not aware of us." He related how the SCA was far more out in the open and well known in Potsdam (where he went to college) so it was pretty easy for newcomers to find them.

Kadlin mentioned a recent editorial in the Democrat & Chronicle about the need to keep college students here after they graduate, to encourage them to keep jobs in Rochester.

We should ask the D&C, Insider, and City newspapers to feature us in articles, Sigvaldi suggested. Katja added that we should at the very least have our regular practices and meetings listed in those newspapers, as we sometimes have had in the past. Thomas noted that City had Boldo listed as the contact for heavy weapons practice in the past. Those present agreed that the contact names for such listings should be the marshals or guild masters.

After much discussion of the type of publicity & recruitment needs and different methods or ideas for pursuing them, Peregrine summarized the two major categories:

1. Physical presence: demos or information tables at local annual festivals (Park Avenue, Corn Hill, Lilac, East End, various town and county ones); gaming, science fiction, etc. conventions (Astronomicon, Rudicon, RunningGAGG); college activities fairs (UR, RIT, MCC, etc.).
 2. Media: weekly/monthly activity entries for regular practices & meetings, and requesting features for upcoming events in area newspapers (City, Insider, D&C); cable and/or radio coverage (WXXI, Channels 8 & 13, RNews, ROC Loop); class listings in area adult education courses and JoAnn's or Michael's; posters at universities, coffee shops, etc.;
- * Topics also discussed included revamping the barony webpage's metadata or keywords so that it pops up immediately in a Google search of "SCA Rochester NY" and creating short activity or introductory videos for YouTube.

The following gentles volunteered to contact/gather more information on the following assignments, and will report on their findings at the September 18 business meeting:

1. Katja: Insider Newspaper
2. Peregrine: RNews scrolling activity calendar
3. Kadlin: ROC Loop
4. Yasmina: City Newspaper, RIT activity schedule
5. Eldjarn: UR activity schedule
6. Sigvaldi: MCC activity schedule

Those present agreed that we needed to create updated flyers and recruitment literature and demo tips specifically oriented for recruitment (not oriented toward education, as in ADEPT).

Kadlin agreed to have the September 4 social meeting topic be on improving recruitment literature. Gentles are encouraged to bring suggestions and examples of good recruitment literature from other groups.

Peregrine plans to ask Orianna at the August business meeting to contact the kingdom media relations officer regarding coverage of Crown Tourney.
