Knight Marshal – Khalek: no report.

Fencing – Padriag: Fencing has been happening with 3 to 13 people showing up, I have also attended a couple of fencing practices at Geneseo.

Archery – Eldjarn: This past summer season has seen several Thescoreans participate in target archery. We have been a fairly small band, but dedicated in achieving regular shooting and improving our skills. In this all have been successful. We have even seen the Rankings of a few individuals improve since even as recent as Pax.

Edmund's time as a Marshal-in-Training is all but complete - he should very soon be granted a full Marshal warrant.

We will be holding our regular practice at RIT this Sunday Oct. 24, but the following Sunday's practice, Oct. 31, is canceled due to the holiday.

Beyond then we will continue as the weather and falling temperatures allow. It will not be long before outdoor shooting goes on hiatus until spring. Come shoot now while we still can!

Consulting with the regular participants at archery, I have decided we will not hold formal weekly practices during the winter. This is due to availability of indoor ranges plus additional expense & travel. However, there is an indoor range near Suburban plaza in Henrietta where informal, evening shooting will be taking place at our archer's whim. ## NOVEMBER

BARONIAL CURIA

October 5, 2010

Officer Reports:

Seneschal – Orianna: Quarterly report submitted September 1<sup>st</sup>. Attended the pre-Curia Curia of Their Majesties at Harvest Raid. Curia will be held at the Hallowtide event in Blackwater. The polling to move the Albion zip code to the Hael did not pass (2 in favor, 3 against). Finished sorting and moving the seneschal files to plastic storage boxes with lids.

Exchequer – Alina: The Barony has \$3,749.03 in the checking account and \$3,470.69 in the savings account. Since the last curia, I have completed the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter report which shows a net loss of \$872.67 and the event report for Pax Interruptus which shows a profit of \$430.96. (note during Curia – the loss is in large part due to the purchase of the Baronial flies –Orianna)

Heraldry – Kadlin: Since assuming office, I have cleaned and purged the heraldic files and reduced them from 2+ boxes to one. There has been one submission for a name and device.

Thrown Weapons – Sigvaldi: Throwing practice has been continuing on a weekly basis, with only a few exceptions. On average there are at least 4 throwers, sometimes more. We have had 4 new throwers, 2 who have been attending regularly. We have been throwing spears as well as knives/axes, and the experimental spear target built with Thescorre funds has proven very effective, lasting almost an entire season.

As champion, I represented the Barony at the Seven Pearls tournament at Summer's End in Beau Fleuve. I also assisted marshaling at that event, and was lead marshal at Hunter's Moon in Hartstone. The two MIT's (Kadlin and Elzbieta) have proven their worth, and will be submitting paperwork for marshallate in the near future. The upcoming winter project in the throwing community is to develop a Youth Throwing program. At the suggestion of Baron Caleb of Rhydderich Hael, I will likely be playing a key role in the development of this project. The throwing season is not yet over, but with the turning of the season will end soon. I encourage anybody who wishes to try this activity to come to practice in the next few weeks.

Minister of Arts & Sciences – Adren: The arts and sciences are well and thriving in the Barony. The scribal guild is making scrolls, dancing is occurring. I need someone to provide refreshments for the November social meeting. The topic of the social meeting will be "costume for every body" presented by Portia. Reminder that the Arts & Sciences Pentathlon occurs at Ice Dragon and I encourage everyone to enter.

Current Status

\*All Fewmets, AEstels, and Pikestafs currently in my possession have been sorted and are being scanned into digital form.

\*I have transcribed one Pennsic Notebook and am in the process of going through boxes of old SCA papers to find ones that pertain to the Barony.

Goals For the Coming Year

\*I would like to have everything I currently have, scanned and put up on the internet for everyone to access.

\*I plan to start with pictures once I have text files completed.

\*Have a link from the current Thescorre site to the "History Of" site, which I will be creating.

Questions

\*It has been discussed that one way to share the current history files that we have would be to make some scrapbooks that could be brought to Barony events for the populace to enjoy. If this is interesting to the Barony as a whole, then I will begin this process. Since the papers and events announcements have been contributed by the entire Barony, I want to make sure everyone has a say in how they are displayed.

\*Does anyone know which of the Corpora standards apply to the Historian position? I have scoured the kingdom site and the Thescorre site, but have found no information on this office, so I need to know a few things:

If I scan in old newsletters (as I have begun to do) and want to put them up on the web, from whom do I need to have permission to do so? Do I need to have each contributor sign a consent form or only the publisher of the newsletter?

What do I do if the writer of the piece has moved "out of area" or quit the SCA? Can I put up the piece with a disclaimer saying that I will remove it if the writer wishes me to do so?

What should I do with things such as: Pennsic Newspapers, pieces from other Kingdoms, etc, for which there are many writers and probably none of which I will be able to get a hold of?

Does the Barony have a time frame within which they would like to have either the scrapbooks or the website complete? (Please remember I have never written a website before, so this may take a little extra time on my part.)

Chatelaine – Dubheasa: The Chatelaine office expires January 2011. I will not be renewing my application for this position. Although I have been honored to serve as Chatelaine for several terms, with a small break, it is time to concentrate on myself for a change. However, I will be more than happy to train the next Chatelaine.

Since the last Curia, I have given information to 20 people interested in SCA. Some of those are people returning to the area. Many are new people with no SCA experience. Two of the people were nurses at Park Ridge Hospital, who treated me after

my knee replacement surgery. One is interested in history in general. The other is interested in medieval castles and architecture. Two of the people are my in-home physical therapist and her daughter; both are interested in English Country dancing.

There was supposed to have been an official SCA demo at the Rochester Pagan Pride Day Festival in September. However, when the organizer of that event finally realized we do not participate with live steel and horses, she broke off contact. She would not return any emails to me.

Chirurgion – Nikki (Acting): still no word from the Kingdom on my warrant.

Gold Key – Nikki: Lots of stuff received over the summer. Finally got to an inventory. Sewers or needleworkers in the Barony have some work if they would like it. Garb taken in: 4 dresses, 3 pairs of pants, 1 cloak, 1 corset, 1 tabard, 3 hats, 5 tunics, 3 skirts, 1 chemise, 1 purse. Garb removed: 1 pair of pants. Feast gear: taken in various plates and cups. Items borrowed: 7 outfits.

Their Excellencies – Aquila and Bronwyn: Had a great time at Crown.

AEthelmearc Academy – Kadlin: Since last report, this event has become a Royal Progress. I will be contacting TRM's to find out if we will need additional rooms for vigil in addition to setting up a royalty room (Orianna will coordinate). I will request the use of additional rooms as necessary. With royalty coming, we can expect an increase in attendance, therefore, I will be increasing the lunch budget accordingly. Andrew will be posting to the list when he needs help with pre-event cooking. He is going to be looking for refrigerator space in the days before the event. Gentles wishing to help with cooking lunch should contact him directly. Sign-ups for kitchen clean-up will be out at the next few meetings. Volunteers will be needed for tollner as well as clean-up. Look for sign-up sheets at the next few meetings.

As of this afternoon, there are 31 classes being offered by a variety of teachers! The chancellor of AEdcademy is currently working on the event taking place in Sylvan Glen on

Oct 23, but she and I will be working very closely over the next few weeks to ensure everything goes smoothly.

College of Three Ravens – Elzbieta:  
Plugging along. Event announcement will be up by the next Barony meeting. Some classes are already being offered. Lunch and feast plans are moving along.

Discussion points  
Continued usage of Faith Lutheran – Orianna: when we started using the Church in April, it was agreed that we would try it for 6 months and see how it went. General opinion in the room was that we are very happy with the site and want to continue. The idea of donating a sum of money to the church to offset our usage was raised. Fridrikr proposed a yearly donation of \$150.00, payable to the church in August. The proposal was seconded and passed with only 2 abstains and no nays. Alina cut a check for the 2010 usage and gave it to Orianna to send to the church with a nice thank you note.

Sigvaldi raised a question that since the thrown weapons site is actually land belonging to a non-SCAdian who goes out of his way to ensure the area is mowed every week, he would like to show the Barony's appreciation in some way. After some discussion on appropriate and legal ways to do so, it was suggested by Alina that Sigvaldi purchase an appropriate gift card and then ask for reimbursement under office expenses.

Event proposals – it was noted that it is getting to be time for proposals for Baronial Champs and Pax to be submitted.

Thescore Policies and Procedures – Orianna distributed marked up copies of the last version of the P&P that she could find with the changes that have been made included. These were reviewed as well as some minor changes that were noted due to changes at Kingdom or Corporate over time. An updated version of the Policies & Procedures will be posted to the Thescore website.

South Thescore – Orianna reported that a polling was conducted to see if there was

sufficient support in the south Thescore are for the formation of an Incipient Canton. The polling results were not overwhelmingly positive but the group has some work to do to continue forward with a potential second polling in 6 months or so.

### Spiced Shortbread

a recipe from  
Orianna Fridrikskona

4 oz (1/2 cup) unsalted butter, softened  
(I used salted butter since I don't keep unsalted on hand)

1/4 cup sugar

1/4 tsp vanilla

1 cup flour

1/4 tsp salt

1/2 tsp ground cardamom

1/2 tsp cinnamon

1/4 tsp nutmeg

1 Tblsp sugar

In a bowl with an electric mixer, cream the butter then add the 1/4 cup sugar and vanilla. Beat until light and fluffy.

Sift together flour, salt, cardamom, cinnamon, and nutmeg. Add to the butter mixture stirring until the dough is just combined.

Pat the dough evenly into an ungreased pie pan (you can also use an 8x8 or 9x9 square pan). Prick all over with a fork and sprinkle with the 1 Tblsp of sugar. Bake in the oven for 30 minutes or until golden brown. While shortbread is warm, cut it into wedges (if using a pie pan) or squares/rectangles if using a different pan. Let the shortbread cool completely in the pan.
