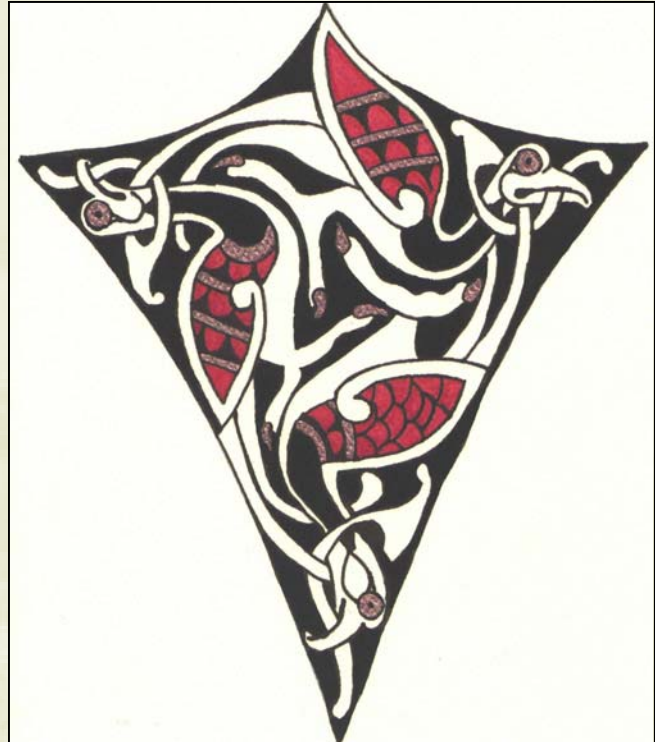

### Thescorre Baronial Curia Business Meeting

- Herald Report

- Exchequer Report
