### Meeting Minutes

#### Gold Key

#### Webminister Report

Yahoo Group – There have been 14 subscriptions and 3 people have un-subscribed.

I have finished the 4th quarter report. The Barony had a net profit of \$2,157.91 as of December 31, 2009. I also finished the 12th Night event report. The event made a profit of \$500.00 .

My quarterly Kingdom report was submitted early.

A Newcomer Night was held on Friday, February 5th, at Matilda's home. 13 SCA'dians participated, including Maeva and Saburou, who drove in from Akron. Four possible new members attended – a woman, her two sons, and a friend of one of the boys. She stated she

Three gentles have contacted me this past quarter, asking for more information about SCA, including one woman I met through Facebook.

A demo will be held for a Girl Scout troupe on Sunday, May 16, at Black Creek Park in North Chili. It will be a partial ADEPT demo, as well as a participatory demo. 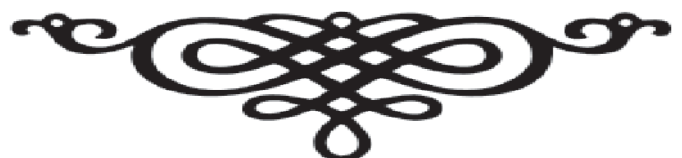

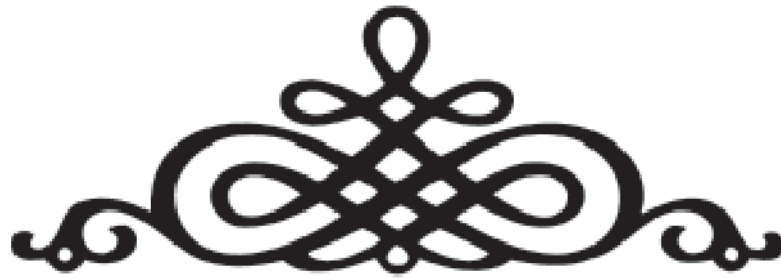
